Naturopathic Medicine can provide a wonderful foundation for your health journey.

Where to Go:

94 Cumberland Street is on the northeast corner of Cumberland and Bellair, one short block west of Bay and one short block north of Bloor. There is a Lettieri coffee shop on the corner, and the entrance is just east of that. My office is in Lifecycles Wellness Clinic, Suite 805 of 94 Cumberland.

What to Expect:

Your initial visit of 1.5 hours will consist of a consultation, detailed history, and naturopathic assessment, which may include relevant physical exam. Then, I will synthesize your information, do the necessary research, and create a treatment plan to address your primary concerns and improve your overall health.

At your second visit, usually one or two weeks later, we will discuss your individualized treatment plan. Also, any remaining portion of the relevant physical exam will be completed on this visit. Treatment plans may include dietary changes, botanical/herbal medicine, nutritional supplementation, homeopathy, acupuncture/Traditional Chinese Medicine, counselling and hydrotherapy.

Subsequent follow-up visits are typically every 4 to 6 weeks. If you are receiving acupuncture as your primary treatment, visits will be more frequent. As you start to experience greater health and wellness, an office visit every three months is recommended to re-evaluate your treatment plan, and for general health maintenance and disease prevention. If ever an acute, non-emergency condition occurs, such as a cold or 'flu, please call the office as naturopathic treatments may be indicated.

Step One:

Please fill out the intake form found under "appointments" at www.dandelionnaturopathic.ca in as much detail as possible. The more I know about you and your health, the more complete the treatment plan can be. Please bring the completed form to your first appointment, along with any recent diagnostic test results and blood work.
